AniMatch, a Massachusetts Animal Coalition program, invites Animal Shelter staff and volunteers who work directly with dogs, ACOs, AniMatch Receiving Organizations and Sending Organizations to a special FREE training seminar on Canine Body Language and Behavior Observation on **September 26, 2016**!

We'd like to invite you and/or members of your staff (including volunteers) that work hands-on with dogs to participate in the next round of training classes. Because we know you are busy and we respect the time constraints you are under, we have structured the first two training modules into one full-day session.

For those of you who are not involved in the AniMatch program we invite you to consider signing up. AniMatch's mission is to help MA animal welfare organizations with limited resources transfer adoptable dogs to other Massachusetts animal welfare groups that have more resources available to find the dogs a "forever home." To date 369 animal welfare workers in MA have participated in these training workshops, including staff from T J O'Connor Adoption Center, Animal Protection Center of Southeastern MA, Second Chance Animal Shelter, Forever Home Rescue, Rainbow Rescues, Berkshire Humane Society, ACOs from Agawam, Mansfield, Foxboro, Springfield, Brockton, Boston and North Attleboro, to name a few. We welcome and encourage all ACOs, shelter staff and rescue organizations to participate so that AniMatch can better serve the animals of MA.

Class Information

Modules 1 & 2: Behavior Lecture and Observational Training

Video presentation of Kelley Bollen*, facilitated by AniMatch volunteers

The morning video lecture will provide trainees with a foundation of dog behavior knowledge consistent with our evaluation of shelter dogs for the AniMatch program. Attendees will learn to read and interpret dog body language and perform the AniMatch Behavior Observation procedure.

The afternoon observational training video will allow attendees to view Kelley handling and evaluating several dogs using the AniMatch Behavior Observation procedure. Attendees will be asked to comment on the various body language and behavioral reactions displayed by the dogs during the observation process.

Module 3: Hands-On Training

In person training with Kelley Bollen *

Under Kelley's supervision, each trainee will have the opportunity to practice cage presentation testing and directly handle dogs in performing the steps of an AniMatch Behavior Observation. The dogs you will practice on have already been evaluated by the hosting shelter.

Modules 1 and 2 must be completed before you are able to attend module 3. Those interested in becoming AniMatch Behavior Observers must complete all three modules. Those interested in becoming AniMatch Transporters must complete modules 1 & 2.
